John 7:37-39 Jesus stood and cried out, saying, " If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'" But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive
Hebrews 12:1-2 Let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the-author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame.

action, keep sober <i>in spirit</i> , fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts <i>which were yours</i> in your ignorance, but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all <i>your</i> behavior; because it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."
Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart, for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, <i>that is</i> , through the living and enduring word of God.
I Thessalonians 5:23-24 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be
preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.
